

VitaShure®-C Precision Release Vitamin C is a feed stable, encapsulated source of Vitamin C for ruminant, monogastric, and companion animal feed. 100% Ascorbic acid is encapsulated using GRAS approved, lipid-coating materials, creating a finished product with a typical analysis of 70% ascorbic acid. Raw ascorbic acid is often lost during common feed manufacturing processes or through prolonged storage conditions. The high quality, barrier encapsulation on VitaShure-C helps overcome these losses through feed processing and storage, ensuring delivery to the animal.

Ingredients:

Ascorbic Acid, Fully Hydrogenated Vegetable Oil

Substrate Composition and Content:

Ascorbic Acid (Vitamin C); 68.0 to 72.0%
Ascorbic Acid; Equivalent to 680,000 mg/kg or 308,000 mg/lb.

Handling:

VitaShure-C can be included as part of vitamin & mineral premixes, meal/mash feeds.

Precautions & Packaging:

Generally regarded as safe (GRAS). Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Heat treated wooden pallet
25-kg (55 lb) poly-lined cartons
30 cartons per pallet (three tiers of ten cartons)

	Growing, up to 1 yr.	6.5 g/daily
Equine	Transported	8.5 g/1 to 3 weeks pre/post transportation
	Performance/ Exercised	6.5 g/3 to 4 weeks pre/post event or daily
	Geriatric	8.5 g/daily


