Balchem & Pharmavite Co-Sponsor Session on Choline, DHA, and Healthy Pregnancies at NUTRITION 2023

> NUTRITION 2023 is the American Society for Nutrition (ASN) annual flagship meeting which was held in Boston, MA, USA. This 3 ½ day event convened top researchers, practitioners, global and public health professionals, policymakers and advocacy leaders, industry, media, and other related professionals to advance nutrition science and its practical application.

> Balchem, along with our partners at Pharmavite, were proud co-sponsors of a satellite event at NUTRITION 2023 entitled "Preterm Birth, **Neurodevelopment, and Nutrient**

Status: The Roles of Choline & DHA." The session featured fantastic overviews from two leading experts in the field - Rima Obeid, PhD from Saarland University Hospital and Kevin Klatt, PhD, RD from the University of California, Berkeley. Dr. Obeid provided a deep dive into the relationship between maternal choline intake and a variety of pregnancy and development related outcomes, ranging from neural tube defects to offspring cognition, and even liver health. Dr. Klatt spoke about the role of DHA in supporting a healthy pregnancy, and highlighted some of his own groundbreaking work showing that choline supplementation improves DHA status in pregnant women.

The session was very well attended with an audience filled with nutrition scientists from across industry, academia, and government. The Balchem team is pleased to be raising awareness about the benefits of nutrition during pregnancy, and are always happy to collaborate with our partners at Pharmavite to share this exciting research.

Consumers Seek Fortified Foods and Drink Products for Health and Well-being

A new report has just been released by Mintel. The analysis covers micronutrient deficiencies that affect people worldwide. Micronutrients featured include iron, Vitamin A, zinc, folate, vitamin B12, and iodine. The analysis highlights negative effects of deficiencies—including reduced immunity, birth defects, blindness, stunted growth, cognitive impairment, and even death.

Mintel's analysis points out that consumers actively seek fortified foods and drink products for health and well-being. The leading food and beverage products with vitamin and mineral claims are sports and energy drinks and baby food. There is an opportunity to extend innovation beyond these spaces.

Mintel highlighted recent patents that bring new technologies to improve the stability and bioavailability of micronutrients in fortified foods and drinks. China leads the way in patents for fortified food products and activity has spiked noticeably since 2019.

In particular, the plant-based space is an area where augmented nutrition can increase the demand for these products. Also, eco-friendly and sustainable techniques to increase micronutrients are on the rise.


